Accessibility statement

Conformity state

The whole Worldline Sips payment pages (Paypages and Walletpages) are in partial compliance with the General Accessibility Standards (RGAA Version 4.0) due to the non-conformities and exemptions listed below.

Tests results

The compliance audit realised by Worldline reveal that 54,6% of RGAA (version 4.0) criteria are met. After some improvements done in 2023, the conformity rate raised up to 83,7%. Other improvements are in progress.

Non accessible content.

Non-compliance

- Some web pages do not have all the required graphic elements:
 - Appropriate style sheets
- Some grouping areas present in several web pages cannot be reached consistently or avoided.

Exemptions for disproportionate workload

The estimated charges concerning the 2 remaining non-conformities are considered disproportionate to the benefit obtained. Both are minor and linked to a common technical constraint.
